

Judy is an Honorary Life Member having joined the club at age 25 following her move from the USA to the UK. Her achievements include winning the Commonwealth Games gold in the 100m hurdles and a silver in the 4 x100 metres relay in New Zealand in 1974. She also competed in the Olympics in Munich in 1972 in the 100 metre hurdles and she was a member of the 4 x100 metre relay team that set a new British record in the final. Judy was also instrumental in developing the 400 metre hurdles race for women and in 1973 she ran several times setting a World Best in the event and also setting 2 British records. Following her retirement from international athletics Judy continued to compete for the club for many years. She qualified as a Senior Coach (level 4) in hurdles in 1982. Judy was National Event Coach for sprint hurdles for 10 years and helped develop the event travelling to many competitions for Great Britain and coaching numerous athletes to international success.

Judy has also been involved in coaching development for England qualifying as a senior tutor. She has worked for England in delivering many coaching courses and also helping coaches at Sutton and District and other clubs achieve their current coaching awards. Judy now has retired from active coaching but with her husband John remains an avid follower of the sport and continues to retain a keen interest in Sutton and District AC. Glad to have you onboard!
