INTRODUCTION!


Hello Members



A former elite level gymnast, Jade is now concentrating on athletics.

At 15, she twice improved the UK best in 2007 and 2008, as well as the U17 record, setting a personal best of 4.05m at the Commonwealth Youth Games in India. "I was going to Poland and India – I was on a high". Taking time out to recuperate from injury setbacks, Jade showed tenacity and later returned more focused. Such commitment has paid off as she holds the UK junior outdoors record and is the current British Athletics Indoors Champion!

Jade has put a lot of the credit down to the support of her family: "I want to thank my dad. He has been a massive support throughout the year and we have bounced off each other. I hugely appreciate his support and encouragement."
