
INTRODUCTION!


Hello Members

Sutton and District Athletics Club was formed in 1985.

Mitcham AC (who were originally residents at the News of the World track in the grounds of Canons Leisure Centre, Mitcham) merged with Sutton and Cheam Harriers (who were based at Sutton United's current football ground at Gander Green Lane) to become 'Sutton and District AC'.

The club was renamed for a number of reasons: (1) there was already a Sutton athletics club in St Helens in the North of England and (2) Mitcham was outside of the London Borough of Sutton and so 'District' was added to 'Sutton' to form what is now known as 'Sutton and District AC'.

Our History

Following a few false starts, the Leisure Centre was finally opened in February 2003 by Colin Jackson, John Vernon, Paul Ellis and Brian Hewson. This refurbishment included the <u>only</u> upstairs indoor 60m track in all of Europe funded by the London Marathon Trust, Sport England and Sutton Council, as well as the National Lottery. It was renamed the 'David Weir Leisure Centre' after the London Olympics in 2012, following the success of its famous, local resident and Paralympic champion, David Weir.

We have athletes of all abilities from 10 year olds to Masters, Paralympian, European and Olympic champions. As a Club we hope to continue to encourage and nurture the natural abilities of all our athletes within a safe, friendly, sports driven community - Our members are our Club!


