Lorna Boothe

Lorna is the former Chairperson and President of Sutton & District and is an Honorary Life Member having joined the club at 11 years old. Her achievements include winning the Commonwealth Games gold in the 100m hurdles in a new Games record and silver in the following games. She also competed at both the Montreal and Moscow Olympics. Following her retirement from the track, Lorna managed GB Athletics for 9 years, finishing her term in 2000 as Lead Team Manager at the Sydney Olympics. She has worked for the International Association of Athletics Federation (IAAF) and was a member of the team that formed the IAAF Academy and World Class Coaches Club. As a member of the English Sports Council Racial Equality Advisory group Lorna worked with the Commission for Racial Equality to set up the now thriving programme 'Sporting Equals'.

As well as coach for the England Sprints and Relay teams for the 2014 Commonwealth Games and GB Juniors since 2014 Lorna is on the England Athletics Regional Council for London with a portfolio for coaching and also on the European Athletics Coaches Association Council. It is obvious that Lorna still has a passion for competitive sports and remains dedicated to its development. Glad to have you onboard!
